About The property

- The World Championships include all or some of adult, youth and team competitions
- Previously hosted in Shanghai (China, 2025), Chengdu (China, 2024), Leuven (Belgium, 2023), Seoul (South Korea, 2022) and Paris (France, 2021)
- Hosted annually in Quarter 1
- 4-day event
- 164 participants



Headline Requirements

- One venue with at least 1,000 seated capacity and a field of play minimum size 6.5 m x 6.5 m or 6.0 m in diameter
- Catering and ground transportation services required
- Opening/Closing ceremonies organised by the host

Host City Benefits

- City keeps full ticketing revenue from 600 - 1,000 spectators
- 1,200 paying hotel nights generated
- Host keeps all F&B revenue

About The Property

- An innovative, fully customisable games that celebrates everything that makes the sport special
- 2 week event any time of year

Headline Requirements

- Host fee negotiable based on number and type of disciplines chosen
- One standard and Latin venue and one Breaking venue, each with 1,000 capacity
- Catering for athletes and officials required at the venue
- Opening and closing ceremony provided by the host
- Ground transport from hotel to venues required
- Accommodation for athletes and senior competition officials must be provided

Headline Requirements

- One venue with min 1000 capacity and the dancefloor with minimum dimensions of 13m x 25m
- Ground transportation for athletes must be provided from hotel to venues
- Opening ceremony organised by hosts
- Local marketing campaign to support WDSF ticketing process
