About The Federation

- World Abilitysport roots date back to 1952, when their founder and now recognised father of the Paralympic Movement, Sir Ludwig Guttman, established the International Stoke Mandeville Games, the event that would later become the Paralympic Games
- Recognised as the only international sporting organisation, for the Disabled (IOSD) and member of the International Paralympic Committee
- Currently has 100+ member organisations from 86 countries across five continents.
- World Abilitysport's Vision is 'To inspire worldwide achievements in sport' with their Mission being 'To develop sports opportunities for athletes to maximise their potential.'

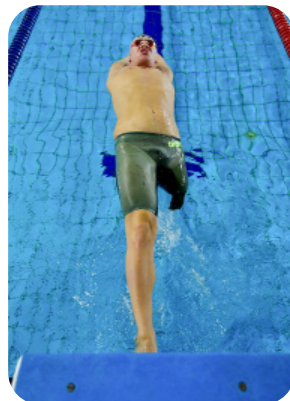

- The Games are a vital mechanism in the Paralympic Movement and continue to play a significant role in the sporting pathways of many of the worlds most decorated Paralympians
