- 2 week event
- Hosted every 2 or 4 years
- Available June to July 2026 onwards
- Previously hosted in London (UK, 2018) and Ostersund (Sweden, 2014)



# Women's World Cup

### About The Property

- The premier womens tournament on the CONIFA calendar
- 6 - 8 Teams of 26 players and officials
- 9 day event
- Hosted every 2 or 4 years
- 25 - 31 matches total
- June to July OR December to January
- Previously hosted in Bodo (Norway, 2024)



# Men's Continental Cup

## About The Property

- A major tournament for non-FIFA recognised national teams
- Featuring 8 teams in Europe, 4 teams in other continents
- 7-9 day event in June to July OR December to January
- Hosted every 2 - 4 years
- Previously hosted at Oaxaca (Mexico, 2023), multiple cities in Portugal (2023) and Linares, Chile (2022)



# Women's Continental Cup

## About The Property

- A key event featuring non-FIFA recognised national sides
- Featuring 8 teams in Europe, 4 teams in other continents
- 9 day event in June to July OR December to January
- Hosted every 2 - 4 years
- This is a new event for 2026, and represents a unique opportunity for a host to support the global growth of womens football



# Headline Requirements & Host City Benefits

## Headline Requirements All Competition Properties

- One 10,000 and one 3,000 seater stadium
- Host to cover some travel and accommodation expenses for teams, staff and officials (numbers differ depending on properties)
- Host to coordinate a local marketing campaign to align with CONIFA's global strategy



## Host City Benefits: All Competition Properties

- 90% ticketing and domestic TV rights revenue retained by the host
- Event sponsorship revenue retained by host
- Domestic TV rights can be sold by the host
- International broadcast and digital media coverage through CONIFA channels (45,000+ followers) and partnerships
